Featured Dive Trip-Lets go bug hunting!!!-4 spots left

On Saturday, February 20th, CIDA has a charter aboard the [Raptor](#) out of Ventura Harbor for an Anacapa day/night trip. The plan is to dive the best areas of Anacapa that we can for lobsters. For the non-hunter these areas will also be good for sightseeing or photography. The 1st dive will be 50'-70' deep, afterwards the Raptor will move to another location 0'-40' deep for both the 2nd (dusk) and 3rd (night) dives.

The dusk dive will give you a chance to familiarize yourself with the dive site as it gets dark during the dive and if hunting, see the areas you may want to go back too. After you are familiar with the dive site, the night dive will be much more enjoyable and you will be able to see how the marine life changes between day and night. Watch closely as the reef changes and some animals go to sleep and others come out to play and feed.

Cost of this trip is \$130.00, includes food, *air and is limited to 16 divers. Boarding starts at 12:30pm with the departure at 1:30pm. The approx. time back to the dock is 9:30-10:00pm.

*The [Raptor](#) does not have a compressor, but does supply steel 72's or 85's for each dive if needed. You may also bring your own filled tanks for the 3 dives instead of using the Raptors tanks or use a combination of the Raptors tanks and your own for the 3 dives. [Ventura Dive and Sport](#) does have 32% nitrox available for a nominal fee using there rental tanks (80's-105's) when diving on the Raptor. When using this service you pay only for the nitrox with the tank rental fee being waived when diving on the Raptor. If you would like nitrox for your dives on this trip, you must call Ventura Dive and Sport in advance at (805) 650-6500.

This trip is good for all level divers wanting to get some night diving experience in.

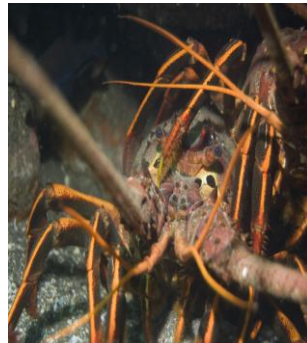
Please make sure to bring a primary and backup light and a chemical light stick or equivalent as they are required for both the dusk and night dives. Surface signal tubes are also recommended on all CIDA trips.
