
Santa Rosa & Gull Islands-photo trip with Joe Dovala

DAN Launches New Case Management System



Enhancements Increase Diver Safety Through Improved Communication and Information Sharing. When divers call DAN® in an emergency, little else matters besides knowing DAN is there to provide the assistance they need. DAN has long fulfilled that lifeline role, but the dive safety organization recently improved its services

with an upgrade to its Medical Services Call Center (MSCC), DAN's case-management system. The MSCC resides at the very heart of DAN's medical and research services. Developed by DAN and used primarily by DAN medical staff on the 24-hour emergency hotline, its data-capture interface allows efficient management of calls, emails and the provision of emergency assistance. Case data is fed into a central database, from which information can be extracted, trends identified and case-management details reviewed. [Read More](#)
